

COVID PROTOCOLS FOR CANTERBURY YOUTH VOICES

Canterbury Youth Voices does plan to have a regular CYV season, though it will look different. Everything we are planning is keeping the personal well-being of all singers forefront in our minds.

- Temperature checks will be done before any singer is allowed to enter the building.
- Only singer, staff and one volunteer a week will be allowed in the building.
- We will social distance when going and coming with separate entrance and exit from the room, if possible.
- All singers will hand sanitize when going and coming.
- Rehearsals will be shortened to one hour to meet the suggested guideline.
- Singers will be provided with the singer's mask, at no charge to them, and this mask will be worn at ALL times. If you would like to see the mask, it can be found at the following link:

- Singers will have a 24 square foot perimeter around each charge to allow for proper social distancing.
- No bathroom breaks will be allowed during rehearsal, unless it is an emergency.
- Music binders will be pre-set on assigned seats so multiple hands aren't touching them.
- The air, chairs, music stands, binders, etc. will all be disinfected before and after use.
- Formal uniforms will not be used this season because of the close proximity needed for alterations and uniform checks.
- Concerts will either be done outside or in large venues to allow for proper spacing. If in person concerts are not possible, they will be recorded or live streamed.
- All rehearsals will be live streamed on a private Facebook group to allow more leniency in absences but still have adequate rehearsal.

In addition, singers will be asked to make a commitment to keep each other safe in the following ways:

- If you have seasonal allergies that cause you to cough and sneeze, for the comfort level of others, you should not come to rehearsal that night.
- You need to take your temperature at least once a day. If you have had a temperature of 100.4°F or higher in the past two weeks, please do not come to rehearsal.
- If you have a temperature of 100.4°F or higher when you get to OCU on Monday night, you will be sent home.
- You should be as responsible as possible in your other activities to protect others in Canterbury.
